## The Challenges

Albany Technical College sought to create a Lean Six Sigma Green Belt and Black Belt offering for the United States Marine Corps Logistics Base, but did not have curricula developed in-house.

The institution saw opportunity in partnering with a third party for content to offer a solution to the USMC Logistics Base's (MCLB-Albany) needs and create a forcredit program.

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### Results and Future Plans

Since 2010, Albany Technical College has had approximately 475 students participate in the forcredit Quality Assurance programs.

The institution has witnessed a steady increase in enrollments, offering one, sometimes two, of the classes per semester.

Albany Technical College has been able to extend the reach of their program to surrounding high schools utilizing the Industrial Operations Technician dual enrollment program. The program gives students the tools and skills they need to excel in various manufacturing positions, while also beginning a pathway to other programs such as Operations Management, Logistics Management, and Industrial Systems.

Albany Technical College has had a successful partnership with OpusWorks® and has experienced growth since the partnership. The institution plans to continue offering the Quality Assurance programs and has implemented Lean Six Sigma education in other departments at the college.
